Richard H. Murphy, 93, of Elyria, died Thursday, April 10, 2025 at Ames Family Hospice, Westlake after a lengthy illness. He was born August 29, 1931 in Gary, Indiana serving from 1951-1953 in the US Army. He was employed from 1953-1993 as purchasing manager at ABEX Corporation, Elyria.
