Joe served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War before becoming manager of the NAPA Auto Parts store in Elyria. Joe was known as someone who could fix anything!

Joe became a Mason in Pennsylvania then joined Scottish Rite and Al Koran Shrine in Ohio. He was a 50-year member of First United Methodist Church in Elyria and a member of Elyria VFW #1079.
