Reverend Joy Obituary

William Kent Joy, 64, passed away unexpectedly February 11, 2023. He was born October 24, 1958 in Sandusky, OH to Lowell and Virginia Joy. He lived in Lakeside, OH and was a 1976 graduate of Danbury High School. The following fall, he met the love of his life, Julie and they were married August 6, 1977. Kent worked at the family Lakeside Marine and served as a volunteer EMT/Firefighter before returning to school to follow his calling to serve the Lord. He graduated from University of Toledo and then served at Park Avenue UMC, Amherst while attending Methodist Theological School in Ohio. He served at Newcomers Chapel UMC, Birmingham UMC, Berlin Heights Lakeview UMC, First United Methodist Church of Mansfield and in 2015 became pastor of First United Methodist Church of Elyria.
