Avery K. Susak, 24, of Amherst, died October 4, 2022 of injuries sustained in an automobile accident. He was born March 7, 1998 in Lorain, graduated from Radford High School in Honolulu, Hawaii and received a Bachelors Degree from the Art Institute of Virginia Beach. Avery's father's career in the US Navy allowed them to live in numerous cities and countries for the past 20 years, including Italy and Iceland, returning to the area within the past 2 years.
