Claudette Mealwitz Obituary

Claudette Jeanne Mealwitz, 83, of Elyria, died October 31, 2021 peacefully in her sleep of natural causes. She was born November 29, 1937 in Canton, Ohio, where she was a graduate of Lehman High School in Canton, Ohio. In 1959, she received a B.S. in Home Economics Business from Kent State University. She was active both in her church and community – a volunteer at the Elyria Memorial Hospital coffee shop and the YWCA Kiwanis luncheons. She was a member of Grace Lutheran Church, the Metropolitan Club, Friends of the Elyria Library, Lorain County Historical Society, the Elyria Country Club and many bridge groups.
