### Wallace Thomas, Jr Obituary

Wallace J. Thomas, Jr., 64, of Oberlin, died December 30, 2020 at ManorCare Health Services, Parma. He was born August 17, 1956 in Oberlin and was a 1975 graduate of Oberlin High School where he was All-State in basketball. From 1975-1978, he served in the US Army. Wallace held positions with Youth & Catholic Charities, was the Oberlin Dog Warden, delivered papers for the Oberlin News Tribune and was later employed as a corrections officer at the Lorain County Sheriff's Department.
