Nicholas M. Hanson Nicholas M. Hanson, 82, of Elyria, died, December 18, 2020. He was born June 3, 1938 in Medina, Ohio and was a 1956 graduate of Elyria High School. He received a Bachelor of Science Degree from The Ohio State University and a Masters Degree in Chemistry from Simmons College, Boston. For thirty two years Nick taught chemistry in the Elyria City Schools, mostly at Elyria High School, from where he retired. He had also been a chemistry professor at Lorain County Community College. He was a seventy year member of First United Methodist Church where he served as an usher and volunteer.
