Richard Calvin Harmon, 88, of Sheffield Lake, OH died June 2, 2019. He was born on September 20, 1930 in Rutherford, New Jersey. He graduated from Lehigh University in 1953 earning a B.S. in Mining Engineering and was commissioned as Second Lt. in the US Air Force Reserve at end of the Korean War. Captain Richard C. Harmon served his country honorably. Dick retired as an executive from Bethlehem Steel Corporation. He will be remembered for his passion for flying, boating, science, history and a love of dogs.
