Her greatest passion was cooking, however, holiday and birthday dinners were a special treat for her children and grandchildren. She always had a bowl of chicken noodle soup for family when they were ill and a chocolate roll on their birthday. At one time she was the cook for the Rathskeller, a popular lunchtime eatery in downtown Elyria.
