Robert C. Lewis Robert “Bob” Lewis, 80, of North Ridgeville, son of Marion and James K. Lewis passed away November 11, 2018. He was born in Cleveland and graduated from Oxford School, attended Columbia High School and graduated from Elyria High School-one of four co-valedictorian’s in the class of 1955.
