Robert Carroll Obituary

Robert E. Carroll, 85, of Elyria, died suddenly December 4, 2015. He was born September 10, 1930 in Roebling, New Jersey, where he lived until moving in 1974. For fourteen years, he was a member of the United States Air Force, serving on a twin engine aircraft during the Berlin Airlift. He received his honorable discharge as a staff sergeant in 1961. Robert was employed for 16 years at General Motors Fisher Body in Elyria, retiring in 1993. He enjoyed the Jersey Shore, deep sea fishing, visiting casinos and the Atlantic City Boardwalk. He had been a faithful donor to St. Jude Childrens Research Hospital.
