David Fackler Obituary

David A. Fackler, 65, of Elyria, died June 30, 2014 at The Cleveland Clinic. He was born February 18, 1949 in Elyria and was a 1967 graduate of Elyria High School. From 1969 to 1971, he served in Vietnam as a sergeant with the U.S. Army. Dave graduated in 1973 from Bowling Green State University with a bachelor degree in accounting and from Baldwin Wallace College in 1990 with a masters degree in business. He was employed for 32 years by Ford Motor Company at the Lorain Assembly Plant and Ohio Truck Plant, where he retired in 2006 as cost analyst supervisor. Dave enjoyed spending time with his family, playing golf and boating and was a member of Bay Point Marina in Marblehead, OH. He was a member of Elyria Elks Lodge 465, Elyria V.F.W. 1079 and Elyria American Legion Post 12.
