## George Rodachy Obituary

George R. Rodachy, 94, of Elyria, died February 20, 2014. He was born May 19, 1919 in Elyria and was a 1937 graduate of Elyria High School. During the depression he worked with the Civilian Conservation Corps. During WWII he served in the U.S. Navy as a pattern maker on the ships Neshoba, Hamul and Renville and was also stationed in Okinawa. He continued his skills as a pattern maker with Elyria Foundry for 42 years retiring in 1982. George was a collector of Indian artifacts and enjoyed woodwork, collecting and refinishing antiques, hunting, golfing and archery. He was a former member of Ohio Archaeological Society and Izaak Walton League of America. George is survived by a daughter, Patricia A. (Blaine) Naylor of Elyria; son, Randolph G. Rodachy of Richmond, VA; grandchildren, Kevin (Molly) Naylor, Victor (Sheila) Naylor and Tammy (Robert) Gunderman and six great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife of 70 years, Gertrude (nee: Vargo) in 2012; parents, Gilbert and Anna Rodachy and brothers, John, Frank and Joseph Rodachy.
