Richard Stein Obituary

Richard L. Stein, 87, of Elyria, died, February 9, 2013 at EMH Regional Medical Center after a brief illness. He was born August 19, 1925 in Elyria, was a 1943 graduate of Elyria High School and attended Bowling Green State University and Baldwin Wallace College. Richard was a decorated U.S. Navy Air Corps Veteran of WWII, serving in the Asiatic Pacific Theatre and the Liberation of the Philippines. He was employed for 35 years at B.F. Goodrich (Polyone Corporation), retiring in 1984, as senior purchasing agent. After retiring, he took on the job of candy maker for Suzin L. Chocolatier.
