Clarence Belcher Obituary

Clarence A. Belcher, 86, of Elyria, died Tuesday, May 22, 2012 after a lengthy illness. He was born June 3, 1925 in Princeton, West Virginia to the late Otis Jesse and Beulah Mae Belcher. He served as a staff sergeant with the U.S. Army signal corps, during WWII, stationed in Germany and also served during the Korean Conflict.
