Jeffie White, Jr. Obituary

Jeffie E. White, Jr., 84, a longtime Oberlin resident, died October 23, 2011 at EMH Healthcare. He was born April 13, 1927 in Ansley, Alabama and attended Elyria High School, where he lettered in football and track. He left high school early to serve with the United States Air Force during WWII and received an honorable discharge and the WWII Victory Medal. He was employed as a welder at Ford Motor Company in Brookpark for 49 years, retiring in 2006. He was a member of Jones Chapel A.M.E., the Progressive Club of the church, formerly sang in the choir and taught Sunday school. He was a former member and past master of Sidonia Lodge #93 F. & A.M.
