### **D**orothy Green Obituary

Dorothy S. Green (nee Saywell), 97, of Elyria, died Monday, September 26, 2011 at The Abbewood in Elyria. She was born May 10, 1914 in Pawtucket, RI and moved to Elyria in 1919 and was a 1932 graduate of Elyria High School. From 1932 to 1939, she was employed as the secretary to the Superintendent of Elyria City Schools. Dorothy was a 92 year member of St. Andrews Episcopal Church, where she taught Sunday School, sang in the choir and was a member of the altar guild. She was a former member of Forthurs of the Elyria YWCA, The Round Table Club, The Four O'Clock Club and Elyria Country Club. She also enjoyed reading, playing bridge and traveling.
