Olga Frank Obituary

Olga V. Frank nee: Dubica, 89, of Elyria, died November 13, 2010 at Wesleyan Village. She was born March 20, 1921 in Lorain and was a 1939 graduate of Clearview High School. Olga was a member of St. Andrews Episcopal Church, the Altar Guild, Episcopal Church Women, and was a licensed lay reader. She had been a volunteer at EMH Regional Medical Center and was recognized for over 18,000 hours of service. She also had been an officer of the hospital Womens Auxiliary Board.
