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George Green Obituary

George Stan Green, 85, of Elyria, went home to be with the Lord Friday, September 3, 2010. He was born March 26, 1925 in Elyria and was a 1943 graduate of Elyria High School. After graduation, he joined the U.S. Army Air Corps, where he served during WWII. After returning home from the service, he was a mail carrier with the U.S. Postal Service for several years. He was then employed in sales for thirty-seven years with Economy Motors, which became Barber Motors and then Steve Barry Olds Cadillac, retiring in 1990. Stan was a member of Emmanuel Lutheran Church; American Legion Post 12 and the Drum and Bugle Corps of the Post; Elyria Elks Lodge #465; Elyria Senior Fellowship and a fifty year member of Frank S. Harmon Lodge #663 F. & A.M. He played golf, was a Cleveland Browns, Cleveland Indians and an Elyria High School sports fan and especially enjoyed spending time with his family.
