She was known for her cooking, especially her chicken paprikash, cabbage rolls and cabbage and noodles. Margaret also enjoyed crocheting and planting flowers in her garden. She was a member of Magyar United Church of Christ where she always had requests for roasters of her cabbage rolls and cabbage and noodles.
