H arold Bruce, Jr. Obituary

Harold E. Bruce, Jr., 96, of Carlisle Township, joined his wife, Jean and daughter, Monica December 21, 2024 after a brief illness. He was born December 12, 1928 in Cleveland, moving to Carlisle Township at the age of 3. Hal attended East Carlisle School and was a 1948 graduate of Elyria High School. He enlisted in the National Guard after one year of college and was transferred to the US Army during the Korean War. After his military separation, he was employed at Bendix Corporation, Elyria. Hal followed in his father's footsteps and became a volunteer fire fighter for Carlisle Township. He retired after 30 years from Bendix and the fire department to pursue his hobbies.
