Taffy Valassis Obituary

Taffy Valassis, 97, of Elyria, died Thursday, October 31, 2024 at The Abbewood, Elyria. She was born March 1, 1927 in Athens, Greece. She was a 1945 graduate of Elyria High School, attended Dennison College and graduated from Bowling Green University with a B.A. in Spanish. After college she worked for her father at the Blue Bird Restaurant in Elyria, followed by several years of employment at various Elyria banks. In 1958, she relocated to Denver, Colorado, and was employed by Frontier Airlines, and for a brief period, in the Frontier office in Durango, Colorado.
