## Sandra "Sandy" Winder Obituary

In the early 1970's, Sandra owned and operated Winder's Day Care, the first black owned day care center in Lorain County. She enjoyed cooking, knitting, crocheting and spending time with her family.

Sandra is survived by a daughter, Deborah (Carzell Logan) Winder of Elyria; son, Kreg Winder of Maryland; grandchildren, Siera Smith and DeeDee Tate; six great-grandchildren and nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Richard Winder, Sr. in 2021; son, Richard Winder, Jr.; grandson, Bryan Winder and parents, John and Virginia Bryant.
