Robert valued education and was passing that on as an important pursuit, much to the chagrin of his beautiful daughter Isabella at times. Robert loved to debate and banter back and forth. When doing so, his smile and smirk were always present. When Robert loved he loved intensely. He would tell us to continue living and be happy.
