Howard Helmink Obituary

Howard H. Helmink, 91, of Avon Lake, died December 6, 2021 at Cleveland Clinic Avon Hospital. He was born August 21, 1930 in Cleveland and served with the US Navy. He attended Dyke Business College and had been employed as an accountant for RESS Realty and later retired from Sherwin Williams. Howard was a member of Christ Evangelical Lutheran church where he was a past treasurer and taught Sunday School. Him and his wife, Genevie, enjoyed traveling the world, including China, Russia, Australia, Egypt and Europe. He also earned the highest award in the Boy Scouts, the Silver Beaver.
