Jessie Everitt Obituary

Jessie Ann Everitt (nee Stiltner) 83, of Elyria passed away March 7, 2017 at the home of her daughter following a four year battle with Alzheimer's. She was born February 13, 1934 in McAndrews, Kentucky and was a 1952 graduate of Phelps High School. Jessie studied accounting and worked as a bookkeeper. As in everything she did, her books were in perfect order and always balanced to the penny. She was formerly employed by Fixtures by Loren, Ames Company, Lake Erie Electric, and the Animal Protective League. She was a member of LaPorte United Methodist Church and was active in Ladies Bible Study. Jessie was a beautiful seamstress and will be remembered through the many gifts she created for friends and family, including 'Power Rangers' Halloween costumes, dresses with a matching piece for a favorite doll and beautiful Christmas tree skirts. She also loved following the Cleveland Indians, her favorite team, and when at home, the game would be on radio or television. Jessie had a beautiful smile and big green eyes.
