## R aymond Malik Obituary

Raymond S. Malik, 79, of Elyria, died August 3, 2015 at University Hospitals Elyria Medical Center. He was born November 27, 1935 in Cleveland, OH and was a graduate of Benedictine High School. Ray received his bachelor degree in education in 1957 from St. Josephs College in Rensselaer, Indiana and continued his graduate studies at John Carroll University. For 16 years, he taught English and was Dean of Academics at Cathedral Latin High School and for several years, taught at Fairview High School.
