James Watt Obituary

James W. Jim Watt, 73, of Elyria, died July 16, 2015 at Mercy Regional Medical Center, Lorain, in the care of Mercy New Life Hospice following a brief illness. He was born August 4, 1941 in Elyria and was a 1959 graduate of Elyria High School. Jim was a journeyman electrician and was formerly employed as a mechanic with J.R. Dall Ford in Elyria, the former Donn Products in Westlake, Bendix Westinghouse and as an electrician with USS Kolbe Steel Plant, Lorain from where he retired. Jim was a member of St. John Lutheran Church, Elyria, where he served as an usher and trustee, played softball and bowled and volunteered with church maintenance.
