Bruce Siffert Obituary

Bruce A. Siffert, 76, of Elyria, died May 19, 2015 in his home. He was born October 11, 1938 in Elyria and was a 1956 graduate of Elyria High School. He also attended Oberlin Business College and was a U.S. Army veteran. He was a former fireman with the City of Elyria Fire Department and then was employed for many years by Don Beal Inc. and retired from Don Moulds Plantation. Bruce was a member of Washington Avenue Christian Church and chairman of the Diaconate. He was a former elder and from 1969 to 1998, served as church treasurer. He was a board member and volunteer of Lakeshore Railway Association and was formerly active in Little League South. Other interest included golf, bowling, fishing and reading.
