K.-Peter Povlsen, 67, of Grafton Township, died suddenly February 14, 2015. He was born December 13, 1947 in Hof, Germany. At the age of 5 he came with his family to the United States and was a 1966 graduate of Bakersfield South High School, Bakersfield, CA. Pete served with the U.S. Army from 1967 to 1972 stationed in Korea and Germany. He received an associate degree from Lorain County Community College and attended Cleveland State University. Pete began his career of over 40 years with Windstream as a switchman and currently was an electrical engineer in translations for Windstream in Twinsburg.
