Harold Terry Obituary

Harold T. Tom Terry, 88, of Elyria, died December 20, 2012 at his home. He was born September 2, 1924 in Elyria and was a 1942 graduate of Elyria High School. He served with the U.S. Army in France and Central Europe during WWII and then received a bachelor degree from Miami University, Oxford, OH. Tom was formerly employed as office manager at Westside Lumber Company in Elyria and retired from Sears at Midway Mall. He was a life member of Wellington V.F.W. Post # 6941 and a member of the Elyria Fraternal Order of Eagles. He was an avid reader, especially Civil War history and also enjoyed bird watching.
