Clifford Hemlinger Obituary

Clifford Edward Hemlinger, 61, passed peacefully December 8, 2012 of natural causes. Born June 6, 1951 in Elyria, Ohio, Clifford was a 1969 graduate of Elyria High School, served in the U.S. Air Force from 1970-1974, and was a 2003 graduate of the University of Akron.
