Wilma Mihalis Obituary

Wilma Mihalis,(nee Keramidas), 97, of Elyria, died Monday, May 14, 2012 at her home. She was born January 31, 1915 in Thisvi, Greece and came to the United States in 1926. She was employed for 38 years at Brandau Jewelers in Elyria, retiring in 2004. Wilma was a member of St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church in Lorain, which her father and husband were founding members and was a Sunday school teacher, Greek school teacher and member of the Philoptochos Society. She had been active in her childrens school P.T.A., the YWCA and the Two Oclock Club.
