### John DeMarco Obituary

John J. DeMarco, 93 of Elyria, went home to be with the Lord December 28, 2011 at New Life Hospice Center of St. Joseph in Lorain. He was born September 15, 1918 in Cleveland and was an Elyria resident most of his life. John was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII, serving in Germany and France and received the Purple Heart. In 1946, He and his step brother Tony Fogylano formed T & J Movers. John joined Western & Southern Life Insurance Company in 1954, where he was a salesman for many years. He was then employed in the maintenance department at Elyria Memorial Hospital, retiring at the age of 71 in 1989.
