Ruth Perozek Obituary

Ruth Ann Toots Perozek (nee Krugman), 76, of Elyria, died Sunday, October 30, 2011 at EMH Healthcare. She was born September 26, 1935 in Elyria and was a 1953 graduate of Elyria High School. She was employed as an x-ray technician at Elyria Memorial Hospital for 11 years and then for 28 years, at Lorain Community Hospital, retiring in 1992. Toots was a member of St. John Lutheran Church, Elyria, where she taught Sunday school for 50 years; sang in the choir; was a youth leader and a member of the board of trustees, womens council and ladies aid. Ruth is survived by cousins, including Deb Schwan, Brad, Joan, Kevin and Amber Smith, all of Elyria; Sarah Jo Smith of Amherst and Sue & Dick Taylor of Kelleys Island. She was preceded in death by her husband of 44 years, Charles J. in 2000; parents Harry and Annabelle (nee Smith) Krugman and a cousin Dale Schwan in 2008.
