### Ada Bedocs Obituary

Ada Mae Bedocs (nee Ransom), 93, of Elyria, died Thursday, September 29, 2011 at Wesleyan Village in Elyria. She was born July 2, 1918 in Cincinnati, OH and was a 1936 graduate of Elyria High School.
