Edward Dulemba, Sr. Obituary

Edward Robert Dulemba, Sr., 84, of Elyria, died Monday, July 25, 2011 at his home. He was born April 16, 1927 in Latrobe, PA, moved to Lorain in 1953 and established Dulemba Transmission in Lorain, which he operated for 30 years and was also a transmission specialist instructor for General Motors. While growing up in the late 1930s in Latrobe, he used to frequent the Palmer Golf Course and struck up a lifelong friendship with Arnold Palmer and several years ago, they played a last round of golf together.
