## Dorothy Pugh Obituary

Dorothy A. (Sumpter) Pugh, 69 of Elyria, passed away on April 16, 2011 following a lengthy illness caused by Progressive Supranuclear Palsey (PSP). She was born in Gassaway, WV, coming to Ohio as an infant. She grew up in Wellington and graduated from Wellington High School in 1959. Dorothy married James G. Pugh in 1961. They moved to Elyria in 1965, where she started working for the Elyria Public School System and eventually became secretary at Spring Valley Elementary School for over 20 years until 1997.
