Jane Lockard Obituary

Jane S. Lockard (nee Stull), 89, of Elyria, died peacefully on Friday, March 25, 2011 in her home surrounded by family. She was born in Lakewood, OH and grew up in Berea. She graduated from Baldwin Wallace College and taught music at Longfellow Jr. High in Lorain for several years. She received her Masters from The Eastman School of Music, Rochester, NY. Jane devoted most of her life to her love of music. This music was an integral part of her husbands ministry. They served in six churches throughout the East Ohio Conference of the United Methodist Church. It was Janes desire to educate and uplift the participants in the worship experience and musical programs. She shared her enthusiasm for music through her teaching of piano, pipe organ, and guitar.
